

We are seeing a light at the end of the tunnel regarding the Covid Pandemic. Testing has become much easier and vaccination availability and eligibility have significantly improved over the past few weeks. Statewide capacity restrictions have been slightly eased for Churches and other gathering places as well.

With these promising trends, Corpus Christi will be making some changes to our current protocols for attending regular Sunday Masses:

- The capacity of the Church and Chapel will be increased by allowing seating in every other pew.
- Pre-Registration is no longer required for attending regular Sunday Masses.
- Names and phone numbers of anyone attending Weekend Sunday masses will be taken at the Church and Chapel Main entrances due to contact tracing requirements.
- MASKS are still required for all masses. SOCIAL DISTANCING within pews will still be maintained. Anyone feeling ill should not attend Mass in person.
- **PLEASE NOTE – Due to usually high crowds for Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Easter, those Liturgies will still require you to be registered as we will assign seating for maximum capacity and everyone's safety.**

We are also looking into setting up a permanent Live stream capability starting in the Chapel to allow anyone to watch masses, Baptism, funerals and weddings from a distance.

We are grateful to those who have been able to attend our Liturgies. This is an opportunity to invite those you know who have missed receiving the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist back to our communal celebrations together.
